- To organize orientation, awareness, and sensitization programmes for students, particularly newly admitted batches.
- To ensure submission and verification of Anti-Ragging Undertakings by students and their parents.
- To maintain an effective Anti-Ragging Helpline and complaint redressal mechanism.
- To coordinate with the Anti-Ragging Squad for regular and surprise inspections of hostels and campus premises.
- To recommend prompt and appropriate action against any reported incident of ragging in accordance with institutional rules and statutory regulations.
- To maintain records of meetings, inspections, complaints, and actions taken, and to submit reports to the competent authorities whenever required.

The Committee shall function proactively to maintain a safe, disciplined, inclusive, and ragging-free environment within the college campus and hostels.

This Office Order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall supersede the earlier committee constitution to the extent of the above modification.
