Functions of the Committee

1. To ensure effective implementation of the Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and all amendments issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India.
2. To supervise proper segregation, collection, storage, transportation, treatment and scientific disposal of biomedical waste generated by the institution.
3. To monitor compliance with statutory requirements and guidelines issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Tripura State Pollution Control Board (TSPCB) and other competent authorities.
4. To oversee colour-coded waste segregation practices and ensure availability of appropriate biomedical waste containers, bags and labels throughout the hospital.
5. To coordinate with the authorized Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) for timely collection, transportation and disposal of biomedical waste.
6. To organize regular training, orientation and awareness programmes for faculty members, residents, interns, nursing personnel, laboratory staff, housekeeping staff and other healthcare workers on biomedical waste management and occupational safety.
7. To conduct periodic inspections, internal audits and departmental reviews to identify deficiencies and recommend corrective and preventive actions.
8. To ensure maintenance of all statutory records, registers, manifests, annual reports and accident reporting as prescribed under the Biomedical Waste Management Rules.
9. To promote safe infection prevention and control practices, including the use of personal protective equipment (PPE), immunization of healthcare workers and safe handling of biomedical waste.
10. To review biomedical waste management practices periodically and recommend measures for continual quality improvement and environmental protection.

Responsibilities of the Nodal Officer

The **Nodal Officer** shall:

- Coordinate the day-to-day implementation of biomedical waste management activities throughout the institution.
- Ensure compliance with statutory provisions and institutional policies.
- Liaise with the Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF), Pollution Control Board and other regulatory authorities.
- Conduct periodic inspections and submit compliance reports to the Committee.
- Coordinate training programmes, awareness activities and internal audits.
- Report accidents, incidents and non-compliance related to biomedical waste management and ensure timely corrective actions.

The Committee shall meet at least once every quarter, or more frequently as required, to review biomedical waste management practices, assess compliance and recommend measures for continual improvement.

This Office Order shall come into force with immediate effect and supersedes all previous orders issued in this regard.
