Functions of the Committee

The Blood Transfusion Committee shall:

- Ensure safe, appropriate, rational, and evidence-based use of blood and blood components.
- Monitor blood transfusion practices, compatibility testing, and adverse transfusion reactions.
- Review haemovigilance data and recommend corrective and preventive measures.
- Develop, review, and implement policies, SOPs, and guidelines related to transfusion services.
- Conduct periodic audits of blood utilization and component therapy.
- Promote voluntary blood donation, awareness programmes, and patient blood management initiatives.
- Ensure compliance with the guidelines of the National Blood Transfusion Council (NBTC), National Medical Commission (NMC), Drugs & Cosmetics Act, and other applicable regulatory authorities.
- Recommend quality improvement measures for strengthening blood transfusion services within the institution.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and supersedes all previous orders issued in this regard.
